### "Legal" Mountain Bike Trails in Santa Cruz County Updated: 2/15/2017 Grey Hayes, PhD

### **Definitions**

'Trail' – any corridor used primarily for recreational use. Because of varying width, material, and alternate recreational/utilitarian uses, it is not possible to further discriminate between the various single track, double track, roads, fire roads, paved, graveled, emergency access, logging roads, etc.

'Legal' – trails that the land owner has approved for mountain bike use for the majority of the year.
